

Seeking participants for research trial on:

Ginkgo biloba Extract and Dementia

We are studying if a dried extract (EGb 761) from the leaves of the Ginkgo biloba plant can stop mild forgetfulness (mild cognitive impairment) from progressing to dementia in people with damaged blood vessels in the brain (cerebrovascular disease).

What the study involves:

- 3 to 4 visits to NNI during the clinical trial within 1 year
- One time blood test
- Participants may be given the EGb 761 treatment during the trial
