What do you need to do?

- Neurological and cognitive tests
- Blood collection
- MRI brain scan

Cost of tests and scans related to the study will be funded by the study.

Participants will receive transport reimbursement for visit to each institution.

- Aged 50 and above
- Have hearing and/or vision issues
